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SECTION 1 INVITATION TO BID

Genera Biomass LLC (“Genera”) will receive sealed bids for the loading and transportation of switchgrass bales at multiple storage sites, with the primary collection and storage site being the Vonore, TN Biomass Innovation Park storage site. The project will generally consist of loading bales at farm sites within a 50-mile radius of Vonore and transporting them to the Vonore storage site. Switchgrass at the farm site or in storage may take the form of square, rectangular or rolled bales, and may be in wrap or other containers, and may be chopped or otherwise pre-processed and in a variety of storage containers. For purposes of this invitation, all such items of switchgrass are referred to as "bales". The project will also include movement of bales from the Vonore storage site or other locations to a range of other end use points. Most of the transportation is expected to occur between sites in Tennessee; however, transportation to or from other states may be required. The contractor will be required to load bales at the farm sites; Genera will handle unloading at the Vonore storage site. The duration of this contract shall not exceed **twelve** months. Genera is seeking bids from qualified companies to provide these loading and transportation services (“Bidders”).

The contract will be between the successful Bidder(s) and Genera Biomass LLC.

*Due to the large number of bales to be transported, multiple haulers may be awarded contracts. However, Genera holds the right to award the contract to a sole contractor if a single entity is deemed capable of accomplishing the task in a timely fashion, within the outlined scope of Work.

Bids shall be submitted using the form provided.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be conducted as part of the bidding activities. This Pre-Bid Conference will take place at 2:00 PM (EDT) Friday, October 22, 2010 at the University of Tennessee Extension Switchgrass Programs office in Vonore, TN. Written and/or telephone questions, inquiries and/or clarification requests will be accepted up to 5:00 PM (EDT) on Wednesday, October 27, 2010. SECTION 2 INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

ARTICLE 1 – COPIES OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

- 1.01 Complete sets of Bidding Documents will be distributed in accordance with the “Invitation to Bid” (Section 1). Additional copies may be provided upon request and approval by Genera.
- 1.02 Complete sets of Bidding Documents must be used in preparing Bids and Genera assumes no responsibility for errors or misinterpretations resulting from the use of incomplete sets of Bidding Documents.
- 1.03 In making copies of Bidding Documents available on the above terms, Genera does so only for the purpose of obtaining Bids for the Work. Nothing in this invitation or the Bidding Documents confers a license or grant to any party for any other use. Genera reserves all rights and interest in Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 – QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

- 2.01 All Bidders must be properly licensed by the State of Tennessee and must have appropriate classification for operation of transport vehicles and equipment. Bidder shall comply with all applicable Laws and Regulations relative to hauling and transporting agricultural materials.

ARTICLE 3 – EXAMINATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS, OTHER RELATED DATA, AND SITES

- 3.01 Upon request, Genera will provide Bidder access to the sites to conduct such examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, and studies as Bidder deems necessary for submission of a Bid. Access should be coordinated through Genera by contacting Damon Drinnon at 865-712-9985 or ddrinnon@generaenergy.net.
- 3.02 It is the responsibility of each Bidder before or at the time of submitting a Bid to:
 - A. examine and carefully study the Bidding Documents, the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and any Addenda;
 - B. make any necessary site visits and become familiar with and satisfy Bidder as to the general, local, and site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work;
 - C. become familiar with all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work;
 - D. agree that no further examinations are necessary for the determination of its Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times and in accordance with the terms of the Bidding Documents;
 - E. become aware of the general nature of the work to be performed by Genera and others that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents;

- F. correlate the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the sites and information contained in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, test, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents;
 - G. promptly give written notice to Genera of all conflicts, errors, or discrepancies discovered in this invitation, the Bidding Documents and confirm the written resolution thereof by Genera is acceptable to Bidder; and,
 - H. determine the Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work.
- 3.03 The submission of a Bid will constitute an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of Article 3, that without exception the Bid is premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by this invitation, the Bidding Documents and using such means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures as may be indicated or expressly required by the Bidding Documents, that Bidder has submitted written notice to Genera of all conflicts, errors, and discrepancies discovered in the invitation, Bidding Documents and the written resolutions thereof by GENERA are acceptable to Bidder, and that Bidding Documents are sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing the Work.

ARTICLE 4 – PRE-BID CONFERENCE

- 4.01 A pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 PM (EDT) Friday, October 15, 2010 at the University of Tennessee Extension Switchgrass Programs office in Vonore, TN. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is not required for bidders but attendance is encouraged.

ARTICLE 5 – SITE AND OTHER AREAS

- 5.01 The sites are identified in the Bidding Documents. All additional lands and access thereto required for temporary facilities, equipment, or storage of equipment to be incorporated in the Work are to be obtained and paid for by Bidder.

ARTICLE 6 – BID SECURITY

- 6.01 A Bid Security will not be required.

ARTICLE 7 – CONTRACT TIMES

- 7.01 The number of days within which, or the dates by which, the Work described in Section 1 is to be completed and ready for payment will be set forth in the contract and shall not exceed **four** months or **120 calendar days**, unless otherwise negotiated. The first 4 months of the contract term will likely involve primarily moving recently harvested bales from farm to the determined storage site. Over the entire term of the contract, the work shall involve moving bales as needed or on a retainer basis. Payment for bale hauling services will be paid on a monthly basis for services rendered during the preceding month.

ARTICLE 8– SUBCONTRACTORS, SUPPLIERS, AND OTHERS

- 8.01 If the bidder chooses to employ subcontractors to complete any part of the Work awarded through this bid, names and qualifications of subcontractors shall be submitted to Genera in advance of the Effective Date of the contract. If Genera, after due investigation, has reasonable objection to any proposed Subcontractor, Supplier, or entity, Genera may request any apparent successful Bidder to submit a substitute before the Notice of Award is given.

ARTICLE 9 – PREPARATION OF BID

- 9.01 The Bid Form is included with the Bidding Documents.
- 9.02 All blanks on the Bid Form shall be completed either in ink or by typewriter and the Bid signed in ink. Erasures or alterations shall be initialed in ink by the person signing the Bid Form. A Bid price shall be indicated for each Bid item and unit price item listed therein, or the words “No Bid,” “No Change,” or “Not Applicable” entered.
- 9.03 A Bid by a corporation shall be executed in the corporate name by the president or a vice-president or other corporate officer accompanied by evidence of authority to sign. The corporate seal shall be affixed and attested by the secretary or an assistant secretary. The corporate address and state of incorporation shall be shown below the signature.
- 9.04 A Bid by a partnership must be executed in the partnership name and signed by a partner whose title must appear under the signature, accompanied by evidence of authority to sign. The official address of the partnership shall be shown below the signature.
- 9.05 A Bid by a limited liability company shall be executed in the name of the firm by a member or officer of the firm and accompanied by evidence of authority to sign. The state of formation of the firm and the official address of the firm shall be shown below the signature.
- 9.06 A Bid by an individual shall show the Bidder’s name and official address.
- 9.07 A Bid by a joint venture shall be executed by each joint venturer in the manner indicated on the Bid Form. The official address of the joint venture must be shown below the signature.
- 9.08 All names must be typed or printed below the signatures.
- 9.09 The address and telephone number for communications regarding the Bid shall be shown.

ARTICLE 10 – BASIS OF BID; EVALUATION OF BIDS

- 10.01 Loaded Ton Mile
- A. Bidders shall submit a Bid on a **Loaded Ton Mile** price basis for the item(s) of Work listed on the Bid Form.
 - B. It is expected that the bid price for Work Section 2 will be the same as Work Section 1, but the two bids may differ if the bidder so chooses.

- 10.02 The Loaded Ton Mile Price shall include such amounts as the Bidder deems proper for overhead and profit.

ARTICLE 11 – SUBMITTAL OF BID

Each Bidder shall fully complete and execute one copy of the Bid Form, and submit it with the other required documents, at the time and place indicated in the Invitation to Bid.

- 11.01 If delivered in person or by postal service, bid shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope plainly marked with the Project title, “Switchgrass Transportation Bid Enclosed”, Genera name and address as well as the name and address of the Bidder as well as any Subcontractors.
- 11.03 If Bid is sent by email, the email subject should include the words, “Switchgrass Transportation Bid Enclosed”, and the body text of the email should include the information outlined in 11.01. Email attachments must be in .pdf form.
- 11.04 In addition to the fully executed Bid Form, the Bid must also include fully executed copies of (a) “Drug Free Workplace Affidavit” as provided in Section 4.1; and (b) Copies of Prime Bidder’s and any subcontractor’s proof of liability insurance certificates and any other necessary documentation of bidder’s ability to complete the Work. Failure to provide these items as indicated on the outside of the envelope will result in the Bid being marked as NON-RESPONSIVE and the Bid not further considered.

ARTICLE 12 – MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BID

- 12.01 A Bid may be modified or withdrawn by an appropriate document duly executed in the manner that a Bid must be executed and delivered to the place where Bids are to be submitted at any time prior to the opening of Bids.
- 12.02 If within 24 hours after Bids are opened any Bidder files a duly signed, written notice with Genera and promptly thereafter demonstrates to the reasonable satisfaction of Genera that there was a material and substantial error in the preparation of its Bid, that Bidder may withdraw its Bid. Thereafter, if the Work is re-bid, that Bidder will be disqualified from further bidding on the Work.

ARTICLE 13 – OPENING OF BIDS

- 13.01 Bids will be opened privately. An abstract of the amount of the base Bids and major alternates may be made available to Bidders after the opening of Bids, subject to Genera’s discretion.
- 13.02 Bids without evidence of proper qualifications as described in Article 2 or not submitted as described in Article 12 shall be listed as NON-RESPONSIVE.

ARTICLE 14 – BIDS TO REMAIN SUBJECT TO ACCEPTANCE

- 14.01 All Bids will remain subject to acceptance for the period of time stated in the Bid Form, but the Genera may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid prior to the end of this period.

ARTICLE 15 – AWARD OF CONTRACT

- 15.01 Genera reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including all nonconforming, non-responsive, unbalanced or conditional bids. Genera may also reject the Bid of any Bidder whom it finds, after reasonable inquiry and evaluation, to not be responsible. Genera also reserves the right to waive all informalities not involving price, time, or changes in the Work and to negotiate contract terms with the successful Bidder. Genera further reserves the right to reject the Bid of any Bidder if Genera believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder.
- 15.02 In evaluating Bids, Genera will consider whether or not the Bids comply with the prescribed requirements, such alternates, unit prices and other data as may be requested, the qualifications of the Bidders and may consider qualifications and experience of Subcontractors, Suppliers, and other entities proposed for portions of the Work.
- 15.03 Genera may conduct such investigations as Genera deems necessary to establish the responsibility, qualifications, and financial ability of Bidders, proposed Subcontractors, Suppliers, and other entities to perform the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- 15.04 If the Contract is to be awarded, Genera will award the Contract to the Bidder(s) whose Bid is in the best interests of the Project.

ARTICLE 16 – INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION

- 16.01 No performance bonds or security are required. Successful bidder(s) is (are) required to maintain and show proof of insurance certificates, including General Liability Insurance and Automotive Liability Insurance to the extent required by law at all times during the term of this contract.
- 16.02 The contract shall provide that Bidder is responsible for any damage caused at the farm site due to Bidder's or Bidder's subcontractor's negligence or recklessness in loading or hauling bales from the farm site. Bidder shall indemnify and hold Genera harmless from any and all claims and liability for property damage or loss, or injury to person or loss of life caused by or arising out of Bidder's performance of this contract, including damage or injury occurring at any farm site or storage site.
- 16.03 The contract shall provide that Bidder is responsible for any damage, loss, or injury to or caused by the bales during transport. Bidder shall also be responsible for cleanup if bales fall off the transport vehicle during transit. Bidder shall indemnify and hold Genera harmless from any and all claims and liability for property damage or loss, or injury to person or loss of life caused by or arising out of Bidder's performance of this contract, including damage or injury occurring during transport. If bales are damaged or lost during transport, Bidder shall pay Genera a replacement fee of \$75.00 per ton of damaged or lost bales.

ARTICLE 7 – SIGNING OF CONTRACT

- 17.01 When Genera gives a Notice of Award, it shall be accompanied by the required number of unsigned counterparts of the contract with the other Contract Documents which are identified in the attached contract. Within seven (7) days thereafter, Successful Bidder shall sign and deliver the required number of counterparts of the contract and attached documents, along with the required insurance, to Genera. Within five (5) days thereafter, Genera shall deliver one fully signed counterpart to Successful Bidder with a complete set of attachments.

ARTICLE 18 – SALES AND USE TAXES

18.01 All applicable sales and use taxes are to be included in the Bid.

ARTICLE 19 – RESEARCH AND DEMONSTRATION

- 19.01 The Project is being carried out as part of The University of Tennessee Biofuels Initiative. The Initiative has the objectives of constructing and operating the cellulosic ethanol biorefinery at the Niles Ferry site in Vonore, establishing a comprehensive program for purpose-grown energy crops, working with UT researchers to leverage state investments and private partnerships for biofuels and bioproducts research and development, and building a commercial biomass industry in Tennessee. As such, an important part of Genera's efforts include development and demonstration of supply logistics and costs for biomass collection, storage and pre-processing. In furtherance thereof, Bidders will be required to agree that any data involved in performance of the Work shall be made available by Bidder to Genera and to University researchers for academic and commercial purposes of Genera. All such data shall be owned by Genera with exclusive right to use or transfer and to publish such data for its sole purposes.
- 19.02 Bidder agrees that its books and records of the performance of this contract shall be open to inspection by Genera or its authorized representative at any reasonable time during normal business hours upon advance notice to Bidder.

SECTION 3 DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK

ARTICLE 1 –WORK DESCRIPTION

Work shall be bid in two separate sections (with the expectation that both bids will be the same for each Work section), with the possibility of awarding multiple contracts. The two sections are based on the areas outlined below.

Work Section 1

1.1.01 Work Section 1 shall include the following actions for moving bales to Storage Location(s):

1. Providing of all necessary equipment for loading at the farm and hauling of switchgrass bales. Equipment and personnel for the unloading and stacking of bales will be provided at the Vonore storage site. Contractor will NOT be required to provide labor for operation of said equipment at the Vonore storage site; however, should unloading service be required by Genera at Vonore storage site from the Bidder, a separate contract will be negotiated and awarded by Genera.
2. Loading of switchgrass bales at designated farm locations. Designated farm locations include the farm locations listed in Appendix A.
3. Transport of loaded switchgrass bales to the storage site, with Vonore, TN Biomass Innovation Park being the primary storage site. Bales will be stored on gravel laydown yards;
4. Weighing in of loaded truck at a certified scale at a designated location in close proximity to unloading site during the hours of 7:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, unless otherwise negotiated;
5. Unloading and stacking of switchgrass bales will be performed by Genera personnel with equipment provided by Genera as designated at the Vonore storage site; Contractor shall not be required to provide tractor or operator at this point, unless negotiated separately.
6. Weighing out of empty truck at the same certified scale at the same designated location in close proximity to unloading during the hours of 7:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Friday, including the collection of a load ticket (unless otherwise negotiated);
7. General cleanup and maintenance of load areas (i.e., clean-up of broken bales, other debris);

Work Section 2

1. 2.02 Work Section 2 shall include the following actions at Storage Location(s):

1. General hauling as needed. General hauling may include transportation of bales from other storage sites to the Biomass Innovation Park, from farms to other storage sites, or from storage sites to other processing locations
2. Loading/unloading of switchgrass bales at designated storage sites or farm locations will be performed by Genera Personnel with equipment provided by Genera; should loading or unloading services be required by the Bidder, separate negotiations will take place. Designated storage locations include the Vonore Storage Site in Vonore and other designated Storage Sites as deemed necessary by Genera;
3. Weighing in/out at scales in close proximity may also be required.

ARTICLE 2 - INVOICING AND PAYMENT

2.0 Bidder may bill twice a month during the first 4 months of the contract term. Thereafter, Bidder may bill one a month. Bidder shall bill for actual deliveries made by a certified invoice, listing the trips and attaching the original certified load ticket for each trip. Genera shall approved invoices within 30 days of receipt.

Bidder acknowledges that the estimated quantities, sizes, weights and locations of farms are not guaranteed, and are solely for the purpose of comparison of Bids, and final payment for all Unit Price Bid items will be based on actual quantities provided, determined as provided in the Contract Documents.

6.01 Bidder agrees the Work section 1 will be substantially complete within 4 months or 120 calendar days (unless otherwise negotiated) after the date when the Contract Times commence to run; Work section 2 will occupy/encompass the entire of the 12 month contract term.

7.01 The following documents are attached to and made a condition of this Bid:

B. Copies of Prime Bidder's and any Subcontractor's Insurance (General Liability and Automotive Liability) Certificates.
