**Genera Energy to Present at Tennessee Valley
Corridor Summit in Washington, DC**

Dr. Kelly Tiller on Speaker's Panel with US Dept. of Energy Under Secretary

(Knoxville, TN) – President and CEO of Genera Energy, Dr. Kelly Tiller, is one of eight distinguished energy innovation panelists chosen to participate in the Tennessee Valley Corridor National Technology Summit held in Washington, DC, May 24-27, 2010.

Dr. Tiller will speak on the role cellulosic ethanol plays in energy innovation with Dr. Kristina Johnson, Under Secretary of the US Department of Energy; Senator Bob Corker; Congressman Lincoln Davis; and Oak Ridge National Laboratory Director Thom Mason.

Department of Energy Oak Ridge Operations Manager Gerald Boyd; Tennessee Valley Authority Chief Operating Officer Bill McCullum; and United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) President and CEO John Welch are among the other notable panelists.

The Tennessee Valley Corridor National Technology Summit advances ongoing collaboration and cooperation among key Corridor institutions, organizations, businesses and elected leaders. The Tennessee Valley Corridor includes the technology-rich areas of North Alabama, East Tennessee, Southwest Virginia, Western North Carolina and Southern and Eastern Kentucky.

Other topics to be covered during the Summit include: workforce/education; national/homeland security, and advanced transportation/space.
